STRIKE CLASS

Fastest, Smartest, Stealthiest

Nite Fury

Fastest species – recorded at speeds faster than the speed of sound (more than 750 miles per hour).

Black as the night that camouflages them, Night Furies are masters of the surprise attack. Dive-bombing and shooting plasma blasts with pinpoint accuracy are their specialities.

Like bats, Night Furies use echolocation to navigate through pitch-black conditions, letting them “see” in the dark.

Currently, Toothless is the only Night Fury known to the Vikings of Berk.



SPECIAL ABILITY: The fins that run down their spines can split into two rows, allowing for better aerodynamics and making the fastest dragons even faster.



WEAKNESS: NO KNOWN WEAKNESSES.

Skrill

Fearsome, mysterious, electrically-charged Skrills are living lightning rods. They surf lightning bolts and attack by firing lightning at their enemies.



WEAKNESS: Water neutralizes their lightning skills.

Fun Facts:

Night Fury : If a Night Fury eats something it doesn't like, stand back, flaming food flies fast

Skrill : Skrills are believed to be electrically charged for hours after an attack

BOULDER CLASS

Toughest and Thickest-Skinned

Gronckle

Slow, lava-spewing, armored dragons with fast-beating wings that allow them to fly in any direction and hover; the only known species with the ability to do so.

By ingesting the right combination of rocks, Gronckles can produce Gronckle Iron, the strongest metal known to the Village of Berk.

Watch out for those eggs. Baby Gronckle eggs don't crack—they explode!

HOTBURPLES are a larger, sleepier Gronckle variant. They still shoot lava, but they prefer eating iron ore to rocks.



SPECIAL ABILITY: When a Gronckle holds its breath, the bumps on its body blast off in every direction!



WEAKNESS: Gronckles sleep more than 80% of every day.

Whispering Death



Nearly impossible to train, these underground dragons make up one of the most ferocious species, with countless, rotating teeth.

A Whispering Death's entire eel-like body is covered in spikes that can be launched at an enemy.

This species' name originates from the whispering noise that comes up from the ground right before one attacks.

What's more deadly than a full-grown Whispering Death? A hatchling Whispering Death. Even though the Whispering Death hatchlings are smaller, they haven't yet learned how to control their spitting spines or their rotating jaws.

Fun Facts:

Gronckle : Gronckles sleep most of the time and can be almost impossible to wake-up

Whispering Death : Whispering Deaths can fly, but their eyesight is weak leading to the occasional crash-landing

MYSTERY CLASS

Journey Into the Unknown

Stormcutter

Proud to the point of being stuck up, these dragons have four wings, giving them great control in flight.

Changewing

With the ability to camouflage themselves and change color and texture based on their surroundings, curious Changewings are the chameleons of the dragon world. They can even make themselves look like other, more ferocious species.

They're extremely dangerous, with the ability to spew acid!

The only body parts that Changewings can't change are their eyes, which they use to hypnotize victims before an attack.

Changewing eggs are very beautiful and look like flowing gems, called Stones of Good Fortune. Stones of Good Fortune are rumored to bring good luck to anyone who comes across one.

WEAKNESS: In the rare times that Changewings get scared, they can't control their color changes, making them visible. They are also vulnerable when out in the open with nothing to camouflage against.

Fun Facts:

Changewing: When threatened, Changewings are known to change their skin color and texture uncontrollably

Deadly Nadder

Deadly Nadders are full of surprises. They can shoot spines from their tails, and their magnesium fire is the hottest of any species. Magnesium fire can even weld metal!

They have a superb sense of smell, perfect for tracking.

Deadly Nadders are very playful, confident creatures, and they love to groom themselves.

 **WEAKNESS:** Deadly Nadders have a blind spot directly in front of their noses and they can only see things in motion



Timberjack

Timberjacks have huge, razor-sharp wings that can cut through just about anything.

Timberjack wings are large enough to provide shelter for humans and smaller dragon species.

 **WEAKNESS:** NO KNOWN WEAKNESSES

Recently discovered species.

Fun Facts:

Timberjack : Timberjack wings can fold up into a massive tent to provide shelter for weary travelers

Deadly Nadder (Stormfly) : All Nadders have a blind spot right in front of their nose

Only The Sea Can Hold Them



Scaldron

These sea-dwelling dragons with razor-sharp teeth use water to wreak havoc. They simply gulp down water, boil it in their stove-like bellies, then blast the steaming-hot liquid out at their enemies.

Fierce predators, Scaldrons hunt in groups and will even prey on other dragons species!

Unlike most other species, Scaldrons are not affected by the blue oleander flower's potion.

Bewilderbeast

The biggest of all species, these rare, ice-spitting dragons are the alpha of any nest, which means they can control the thoughts and habits of the other dragons that live with them.

They are so big that the ice they spit out can destroy human settlements or create mountains out of nothing.



WEAKNESS: NO KNOWN WEAKNESSES, but Bewilderbeasts are unable to control the thoughts of the hatchling dragons in their nests



Fun Facts:

Scaldron : When a Scaldron has a full stomach of water, its body mass is five times larger than normal

Monstrous Nightmare

Monstrous Nightmares not only spew a gel-like fire that coats everything, they even coat themselves so they fly covered in flames!

Not always able to control their fire, Monstrous Nightmares have been known to burst into flames at the wrong times. Word of advice, stay away from a sneezing or coughing Monstrous Nightmare

WEAKNESS: Monstrous Nightmares can lose their ability to generate fire if they are old, injured, or exhausted. If this happens, only the venom from the Fireworm Queen can restore them.

Terrible Terror

It seems like pesky little Terrible Terrors are always underfoot. Just don't be fooled by their size-their flames are huge for such tiny creatures.



WEAKNESS: They're small in size compared to most other species. They also compete with each other for food, wasting lots of energy.



Fun Facts:

Terrible Terror : Terrible Terrors expend significant energy competing with each other for food

Monstrous Nightmare : Monstrous Nightmares have a tendency to unintentionally spit fire at off times, such as coughing or sneezing



TRACKER CLASS

These Dragons Know Where To Go



Hideous Zippleback

Each head on these two-headed dragons has a mind of its own. One head emits gas. The other ignites it. Together they create massive explosions. The gas that Hideous Zipplebacks emit is a tool on its own. It's thick enough to create a cover to hide in. Just don't breathe in too much. It can be toxic!



SPECIAL ABILITY: A Hideous Zippleback can transform itself into a wheel of death. The heads of a Hideous Zippleback grab the tails and the dragon rolls on the ground, leaving a path of fire in its wake.



WEAKNESS: Many Hideous Zipplebacks often stall out, even during battle, because the two heads cannot agree on a next move. Their massive size combined with their relatively small wings don't make them great flyers. Not the brightest species.

Rumblehorn

Rumblehorns are a rhinoceros-like species with skin as thick as armor and horns extending from their faces. Rumblehorns have an exceptional sense of smell. They can track anything or anyone just by following the slightest scent.



WEAKNESS: NO KNOWN WEAKNESSES

Fun Facts:

Hideous Zippleback: The two heads are distinct and do not share thoughts. When disagreeing with itself, the entire beast can stall out, making it completely vulnerable to attack

BOOK OF DRAGONS ASSEMBLY



The Vikings of Berk kept a very good record of all the different dragons they encountered, and now you can too! Here you have the beginning of your very own Book of Dragons, with one page for every known dragon class. As you create new creatures in the Dragon Flyer app, you can add them to your book! Constructing your book is easy, so let's get started!

First, decide whether you'd like the quickest, easiest way to put your book together, or if you'd like to take the time to make it a little fancier.

Simple Assembly:

YOU WILL NEED:

- Tape

1. Fold the cover in half down the spine of the book, so that the printed side is facing out. Set this aside.
2. Fold all of the other pages in half down the center, so that the printed sides are facing in. (Unfolding each page should look like you're opening a book.)
3. Stack the folded pages on top of one another. All of the folded edges should be on the left, and all of the open edges should be on the right.
4. Tape the open edges (right side) of the pages to each other, one by one, so the unprinted sides of the pages face each other. This should make one long zig-zag of dragon pages.
5. Placed this stack of accordion-folded pages inside the cover, as if the cover were a folder holding all of the pages together.
6. Tape the right edge of the cover to the open edge of the Table of Contents page. (Do not tape the back cover to the edge of the last page, otherwise you won't be able to add more dragons in when you make them!)

Fancy Assembly:

YOU WILL NEED:

- Tape
- Scissors
- Hole Punch
- Brass paper fasteners

1. Trim the margins off of all of the pages, so all you're left with is the printed area.
2. Fold the cover in half down the spine of the book, so that the printed side is facing out. Set this aside.
3. Fold all of the other pages in half down the center, so that the printed sides are facing in. (Unfolding each page should look like you're opening a book.)
4. Stack the folded pages on top of one another. All of the folded edges should be on the left, and all of the open edges should be on the right.
5. Tape the open edges (right side) of the pages to each other, one by one, so the unprinted sides of the pages face each other. This should make one long zig-zag of dragon pages.
6. Placed this stack of accordion-folded pages inside the cover, as if the cover were a folder holding all of the pages together.
7. Tape the right edge of the cover to the open edge of the Table of Contents page. (Do not tape the back cover to the edge of the last page, otherwise you won't be able to add more dragons in when you make them.)
8. Use your hold punch to make 2 or 3 holes along the spine of your Book of Dragons. Be sure that the holes are far enough from the edge that you don't punch through any of the folds.
9. Use copper brads (paper fasteners) to secure all the pages together. These are easy to unfasten and re-fasten any time you add a new dragon to your book!
